RE: Uniform expectations

We are proud of how many of our students wear their uniform well and take pride in being part of New Line Learning. Our aim is simply to make sure expectations are clear and consistent for everyone.

Whilst students are in the school building, they should be wearing full and correct uniform, including their blazer, tie, shirt tucked in, trousers or pleated skirt and black shoes. The school jumper remains optional. At break and lunchtime, students may remove their blazer whilst they are sat down eating. Once they stand up or are walking around, their blazer should be put back on and worn correctly.

Coats and other outdoor clothing should not be worn inside the building, and our normal uniform expectations around jewellery, make-up and hair colour continue to apply. More information on this can be found by [clicking here](#).

If a member of staff asks a student to correct their uniform, we would ask that they do so straight away. Students who have an agreed uniform pass should also be ready to show this when asked.

From today, if a student needs to be spoken to about correcting their uniform, they will receive a 30-minute after-school detention. As students have been reminded of this throughout last week, we hope that very few students will need to receive one.

Thank you, as always, for your support in helping us maintain high expectations and encouraging our students to wear their uniform with pride.
