RE: Year 10 Information Evening – Wednesday 16th September, 5.00pm–6.00pm

We are delighted to invite you to our **Year 10 Information Evening** at New Line Learning Academy.

Year 10 is an important stage in your child's learning journey, as subjects become more focused and students begin to deepen the knowledge and skills they will need for their GCSEs and other qualifications. It is a time for students to become more confident in their learning, respond to feedback and take greater responsibility for their studies.

Our Year 10 theme is **Project Progress** – supporting every student to recognise the progress they are making, understand what they need to do next and build the confidence and habits that will help them succeed.

The evening will give you a clear understanding of what Year 10 looks like, what your child will experience over the year and how you can support them at home.

Year 10 Presentation – 5.00pm–5.30pm

During the presentation, we will cover:

- The different types of qualifications your child will be studying and how you can support them to be successful
- The Year 10 journey and key assessment points throughout the year
- Guidance on home study and developing effective routines and how what we need from families at home
- Information about Work Experience and what students can expect

Supporting Your Child Sessions – 5.30pm–6.00pm



Following the presentation, parents and carers can choose one of our short 20-minute sessions, designed to provide practical guidance on areas that are particularly important during Year 10.

Social Media and Sexual Exploitation	Understand the risks young people may face online and how to spot warning signs. This session offers practical tips for starting conversations and helping your child stay safer online.
Supporting Without Taking Over	As young people become more independent, knowing when to step in and when to step back can be difficult. This session explores practical ways to offer support while helping your child build confidence, independence and responsibility.
Work Experience – Finding the Right Placement	Find out how you can support your child to find a work experience placement that matches their interests, strengths and future aspirations. We'll share practical advice on finding opportunities, making contact with employers and preparing for the experience.

Please note that, due to time constraints we kindly ask you sign up for one session only. Resources from all sessions will be shared with you afterwards.

There will also be opportunities to ask questions and speak with staff about how best to support your child throughout Year 10.

Project Progress is about recognising that success is built over time. By school, students and families working together, we can help every young person develop the habits, confidence and motivation they need to make strong progress throughout Year 10 and prepare successfully for Year 11.

We strongly encourage all Year 10 parents and carers to attend and look forward to welcoming you.
