Year 11 is an important and exciting year, and the support students receive at home will make a real difference to their confidence, progress and exam success. This year, our Year 11 journey will be centred around **Project Potential** – encouraging every student to recognise their strengths, raise their aspirations and work towards achieving their full potential.

The evening is designed to give you a clear understanding of the year ahead and practical guidance on how you can support your child throughout Year 11.

Supporting Your Child Sessions – 5.00pm–5.30pm

Choose one of our short 20-minute sessions, designed to give you practical information, guidance and ideas to help support your child through Year 11 and beyond.

Social Media and Sexual Exploitation	Understand the risks young people may face online and how to spot warning signs. This session offers practical tips for starting conversations and helping your child stay safer online.
Kent Choices and Your Post-16 Plan	Get to know Kent Choices and the options available after Year 11. This session will help you support your child with exploring courses, applications and planning their next steps.
Supporting Them to Fly – SEND and Inclusion	A supportive session for parents and carers of young people with SEND or additional needs. We'll explore ways to build confidence, independence and self-advocacy as they prepare for life beyond school.

Please note that, due to time constraints we kindly ask you sign up for one session only. Resources from all sessions will be shared with you afterwards.



Year 11 Presentation – Sports Hall, 5.30pm–6.00pm

During the presentation, we will cover:

- The Year 11 journey and key assessment points,
- Mock examinations and what students can expect,
- Our after-school and holiday intervention programme and expectations for attendance,
- Revision, independent study and how families can support at home,
- Post-16 preparation and next steps,
- Information about the Year 11 Prom,
- Myth Busters.

Students will also receive a **Year 11 revision pack** containing key resources and equipment to support effective study and revision at home.

There will be opportunities throughout the evening to ask questions and speak with staff about how best to support your child. Working together is a key part of **Project Potential**, and your involvement will play an important role in helping your child approach Year 11 with confidence, ambition and the support they need to succeed.
